JOB SUMMARY:

The primary role of the Personal Care Specialist is to provide for adult client's daily living needs and personal care needs.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBLITIES:

- 1. Assist with daily living skills of both male and female clients to include: toileting, tube feeding, feeding, and dressing with the primary function of this position assisting with bathrooming needs.
- 2. May administer medications and individual care plans.
- 3. Assist with lunch time set up, including clients who are tube fed.
- 4. Provide assistance in the classroom setting, including range of motion in exercise classes and locker room assistance.
- 5. Perform any other duties deemed necessary by management.
- 6. Adhere to the agency safety policies and procedures as communicated by the Safety Committee.
- 7. Perform housekeeping tasks of learning, lunch clean-up etc.
- 8. Responsible for timely and accurate documentation as needed.
